**EMERGENCY PROCEDURES 24 HOUR ADVICE IN AN EMERGENCY ONLY 0800 243 622**

IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
<b>Tanker/Vehicle Accident</b>	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. <b>Call the emergency services: Dial 111</b>
<b>Spill or leak</b>	Use appropriate protective equipment. Clear area of unnecessary personnel. Spills should be cleaned up immediately. <b>Large Spill:</b> Contain and recover as much as possible to a salvage container. Do not allow product or run-off to enter waterways or drains.
<b>Fire</b>	<b>Call the Fire Service: Dial 111.</b> Self-contained breathing apparatus required. Smoke may be toxic. Do not allow contaminated run-off to enter drains.

**FIRST AID 24 HOUR ADVICE IN A FIRST AID EMERGENCY 0800 POISON (0800 764 766)**

<b>If Swallowed:</b>	Do NOT induce vomiting. Rinse mouth. Contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764 766) or a doctor for advice.
<b>If in Eyes:</b>	Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
<b>If on Skin:</b>	If skin contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and wash skin with soap and water. If irritation or rash persists, get medical attention.
<b>If Inhaled:</b>	Move person to fresh air immediately and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. Get medical advice if person feels unwell.
